Goals to improve Student Learning and Achievement

- Achievement targets are set for all year levels, including national standards and with a particular focus on priority learners, and these are monitored to ensure they are fully engaged. (HOD/TICs, BD, MY,FL,SM)
- The place of Māori & Pasifika students in our school is recognised and acknowledged; learning needs are catered for and celebrated. (NK/VA/EP)
- Standardised testing is implemented into Years 9 & 10 (MY/SM)
- A new template for reporting achievement at Years 9 & 10 is introduced (HOD/TICs)
- A.R.T practices are embedded to support at risk students in achieving Level 2 of NCEA (WP/PJ/HOD/TICs)
- Teachers will share assessment information with students and provide explicit feedback in meeting learning goals. (HOD/TICs)
- Improve the quality of bookwork across all year levels. (HOD/TICs)

Students

Goals to achieve a quality learning environment

- The Year 9 & 10 curriculum is explored to see ways in which ICT may be further implemented in every classroom. (HOD/TICs)
- School wide professional development programmes that focus on Strategic goals, PTC 3 & 10, Ka Hikitia – Accelerating Success and the Tataiako documents, PB4L, Special Needs, teaching International students and the recommendations as found in the last ERO report. (Mngt Team)
- Urban Concept Farm: develop an *urban*, Science & Technology, outside learning space in the context of sustainable Agriculture. (MS)
- Active Education: through research consider 3 critical questions around active learning. (RE)
- Develop policy and procedure to embed practice around new legislation under the revised Education Act, Health and Safety and Vulnerable Children Acts. (BoT & GR)

Teaching

Goals for the KVC environment to support Learning

- To implement a well overdue 5YPP including an updated rationalisation plan. (Prop Comm)
- A new Music Suite is developed in B Block.
- The college becomes more actively involved in the community to optimise exposure (Mngt)
- Action plans are developed to raise the profile of the school within the community and to bring about increased tasks at Years 7 & 9.
- Effective financial management systems are in place.
- A strategic plan is in place for ICT, that takes into account current plant and explores wider use of technology e.g. chrome books in teaching and learning. (SA/CG)
