

CHILDCARE AND DEVELOPMENT

CCD 202

This course is designed for responsible students at Year 12/13 who are genuinely interested in participating in a childcare programme. This is a one year course so can only be studied once at either Year 12 or Year 13.

Students who meet the criteria have field work experience working with pre-schoolers in the home environment. Internal assessment activities are based around the care and educational requirements of young children.

Students also receive a Kaikorai Valley College Certificate in Childcare and Development.
