There are three internally assessed standards which are mainly practical performance activities but there is a greater emphasis on portfolio and written work in Year 13 and the two externally assessed Achievement Standards require a commitment to reading scripts, attending live theatre and keeping detailed written records.

It would be possible for a highly motivated student to take Level 3 Drama without having studied it previously but it would need to be discussed with the Head of Department. Students are expected to take an acting or technical role in a school production.
