

# ENGLISH

All Year 12 students study English. Two courses are offered and English teachers will indicate which is the more appropriate course for you to follow based on your Level 1 results.

## ENG 201

Eng 201 is for students who have demonstrated through their Level 1 that they have good all round English skills and are capable of meeting the demands of the Level 2 English Achievement Standards. A minimum prerequisite for this course is Achievement level for at least four Level 1 English Achievement Standards, one of which must be an external Achievement Standard. 10 Literacy credits at Level 2 are prerequisites for some tertiary education courses.

The 201 course will consist of a selection of the new realigned English Achievement Standards from the following list:
