## GAW 202

Gateway is for Year 12 and 13 students who have a clear idea about their career direction and would like to begin their work qualifications and gain workplace experience while still at school. Gateway students complete a minimum of 20 days during the year in a work placement. During this placement and at school, students study and complete workplace qualifications. Each student has an individual training programme designed to match their desired qualifications.

Assessment is in industry Unit Standards or Achievement Standards which also count towards NCEA. The assessment usually occurs, in or at the workplace. For some career choices students study Polytechnic courses.

**Limited numbers will be able to enter this course.**

Entry to this course is by application and interview. The application and interview process is carried out in November of the year before participation. The student is assessed for their attitude and ability to work independently.
