TEV 101

[Visual Design and Communication]

The programme enables students to develop the identified graphic communication skills in sketching, design development and refinement, colour rendering, production drawing, presentation and modelling. Students are expected to identify and use design principles to articulate their design ideas.

Internally assessed credits are based around design assignments. Externally assessed standards are in the form of specific drawing 'types' completed as part of assignments, which are marked externally in the end of year portfolio submission.
