GRA 301

This is an approved subject for University Entrance

The programme enables students to develop the identified graphic communication skills in sketching, design development and refinement, colour rendering, production or 'working' drawings, presentation and modelling.

Students are expected to analyse the nature of the problem identified in a brief and generate new solutions or produce alternatives to existing designs. Students will be assessed on their ability to develop and communicate design concepts in the areas of media and technical illustration, engineering and technological design, and architectural and environmental design.

Students are required to work on real projects with real clients and there is flexibility as to the specific assignments to be undertaken.

Internally assessed credits are based around three design assignments. Externally assessed standards are also taken from those design assignments but marked externally.

Approximately 24 credits are available.

Courses relevant to individual students will be arranged at the beginning of 2012.
