

# TE REO MĀORI

## MAO 101

Students who wish to study Te Reo Māori (Māori language) will be able to follow a flexible course which allows them to achieve at their own level. Achievement Standards will be available for the more able students, and Unit Standards for the students who find the Achievement Standards too difficult (at this level Unit Standards have half the credit value of Achievement Standards). Motivated students may attempt MAO 101 without prior experience, but need to be aware a good deal of work is required to achieve even Unit Standards.
