Students will participate in a variety of 2 or 3 practical-based activities. Internal assessment will cover garment construction, experimentation with techniques and processes based on 2-3 garments.

Assignments will focus on principles and elements of design and prototyping. The course includes both internal and external Achievement Standards at Level 1.
