The selection panel may at any time suspend or terminate any scholarship, or require the forfeiture of such proportion of the scholarship as the panel may determine, if it is satisfied that the scholarship holder has failed to comply with any of the terms and conditions on which the scholarship was granted.

All applications will be processed by the selection panel. The panel will consist of the HOD/TIC of Drama, Art, Music and the Principal.

The selection panel reserves the right to interview applicants if it chooses.

Applications close Friday 2 December 2016.

The selection panel will make their decision by mid-February 2017.

The successful applicant will be advised following the decision.
