Course of Study

Year 11 Independent Living Skills is a foods based programme which is internally assessed using Unit Standards. Students participate in a variety of practical activities including budgeting, basic food hygiene, storage of food and the preparation and cooking of light meals and snacks.

Unit standards cover:

- Food handling skills.
- Developing knowledge of practices and strategies required to address food handling issues.
- Enhancing self-worth through successful and safe preparation of food personally and as a shared responsibility.
- Planning a budget for a family.
- Baking skills.
- Examining influences on personal wellness.
