LEVEL 1

Credits: 18 - 22

Leads on to: Level 2 Music

This course will most likely be delivered through a multilevel class.

Course description

The Music course enables you to develop knowledge and understanding of Music in past and present contexts. You will experiment with the elements of music to structure compositions. As you rehearse and perform as an individual and as a group, you will develop fluency and musicianship. You will have an opportunity to use technology as it relates to music.

Course of Study

Details of the course will be decided when the composition of the class is known, with the aim of achieving between 18 and 22 credits. A selection will be made from the following:

- solo and / or group performance
- composition
- score reading (applied music theory)
- the study of two music works
- **either** knowledge of and use of a sound system for performance, **or** knowledge of and use of MIDI.

LEVEL 2

Credits: 18 - 24

Leads on to: Level 3 Music

This course will most likely be delivered through a multilevel class.

Course Description

The Level 2 Music course builds on the skills developed at Level 1.

Course of Study

Details of the course will be decided when the composition of the class is known, with the aim of achieving between 18 and 24 credits. A selection will be made from the following:

- solo and /or group performance
- performance on a second instrument
- composition
- instrumentation
- score reading (applied theory)
- the study of two music works
- investigation of a New Zealand music topic
- research recording technology

Costs: \$90 for Itinerant Music Tuition if required through the school and Chamber Music Competition entry fee where applicable.

LEVEL 3

Credits: 18 - 24

Leads on to: Music at Tertiary Level

This course will most likely be delivered through a multilevel class

Course Description

The Level 3 Music course builds on the skills developed at Levels 1 and 2, allowing for the specialisation in areas of strength.

Course of Study

Individual students select areas of study in consultation with the teacher. The following are available:

- solo and /or group performance
- performance on a second instrument
- composition
- arranging music
- studies of music works
- research a music topic
- harmony
