

VISUAL ARTS

Art at Year 10 covers a wide and varied range of activities which may include computer design, photography (both digital and darkroom), painting, printmaking and 3 D work. This gives students the opportunity to discover which field of the visual arts appeals to them.



Students will develop their practical knowledge in the visual arts by making objects and images. The programme also develops their ability to generate and develop ideas.

Students will study the art of Aotearoa (New Zealand) and of other cultures. They will develop research skills and the ability to interpret meaning in objects and images created by others. They will look at the context in which art works are made.

A key objective of the Year 10 course is to provide students with the skills they will need to successfully complete Level 1 NCEA the following year.
